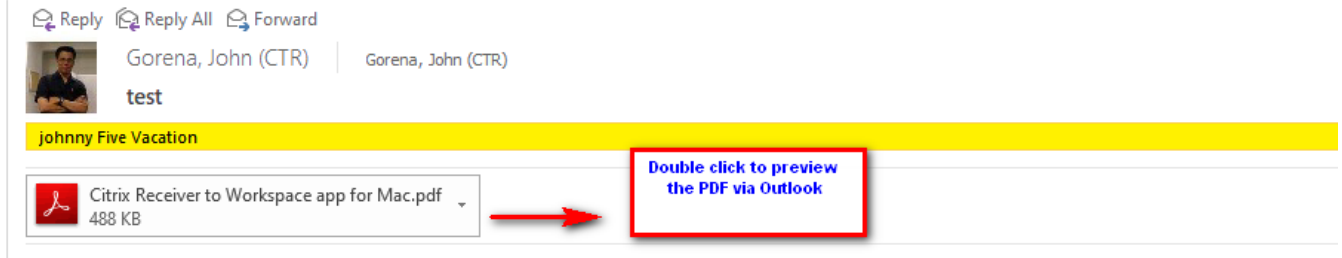

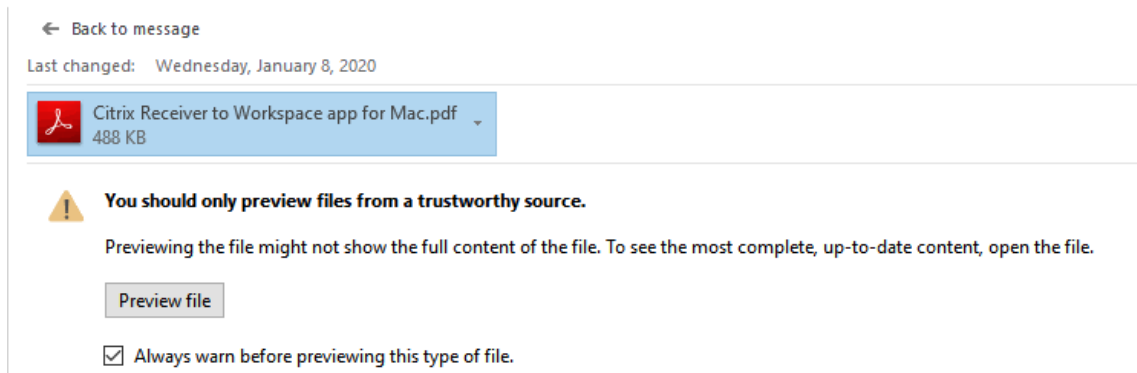


Preview PDF's via Outlook

Open your email and access click on the email that has the PDF attachment and double click on the attachment file

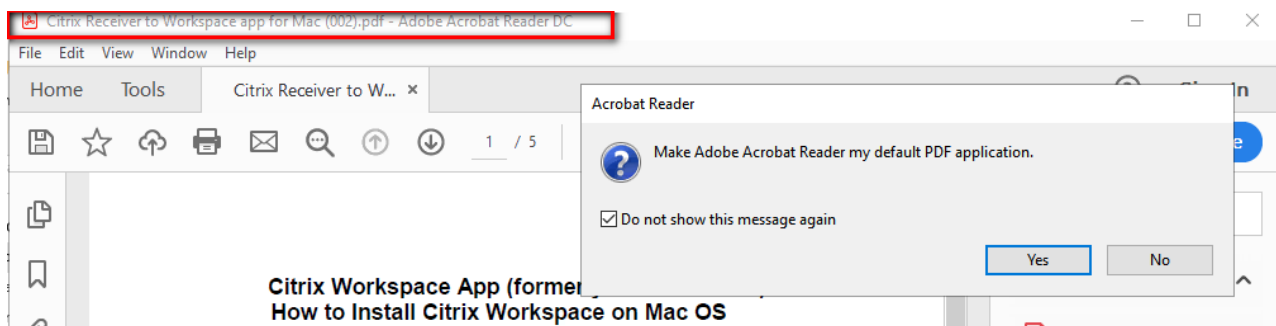


make sure the Preview file check **"Always warn before preview this option of file"** is checked and preview the file in the outlook pane.

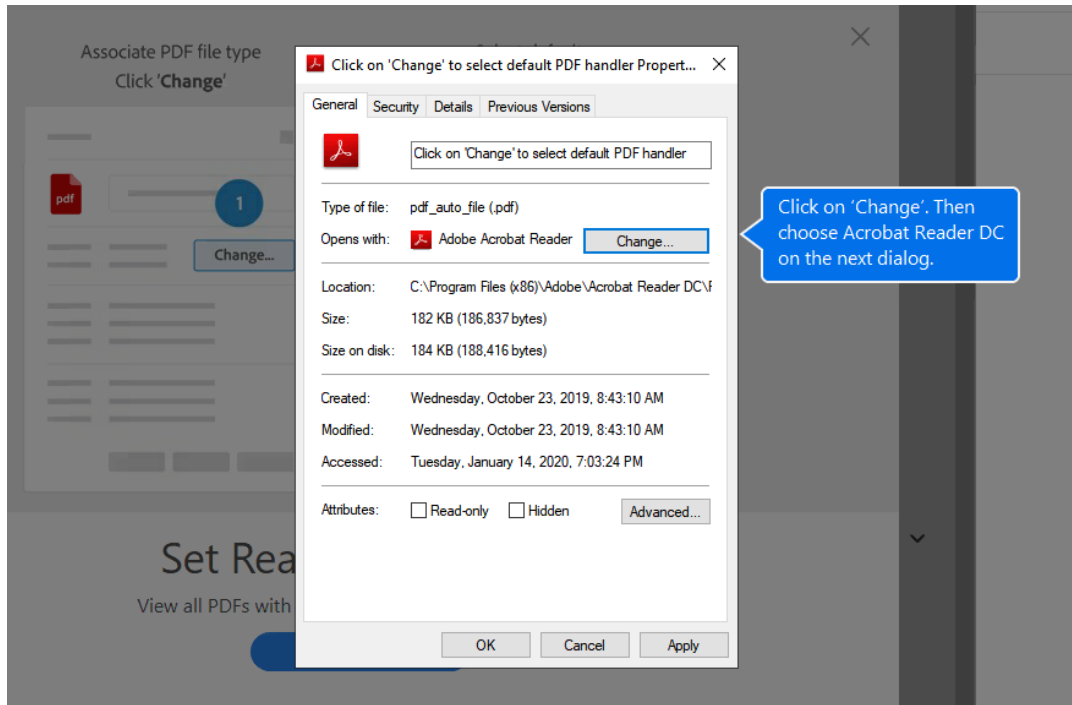


Open PDF files from outlook

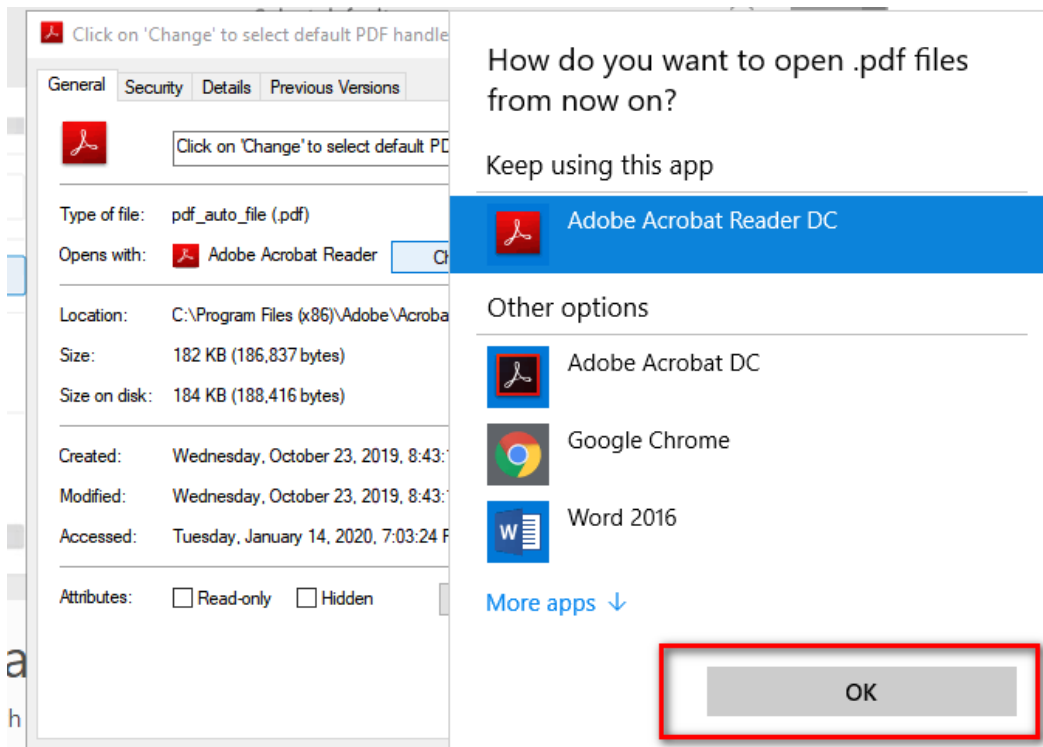
Double click on the attachment and you will be prompt to make adobe acrobat reader as my default PDF application and make sure to check the option "Do not show this message again"



you will be prompt as follows and choose the option **"Change"**

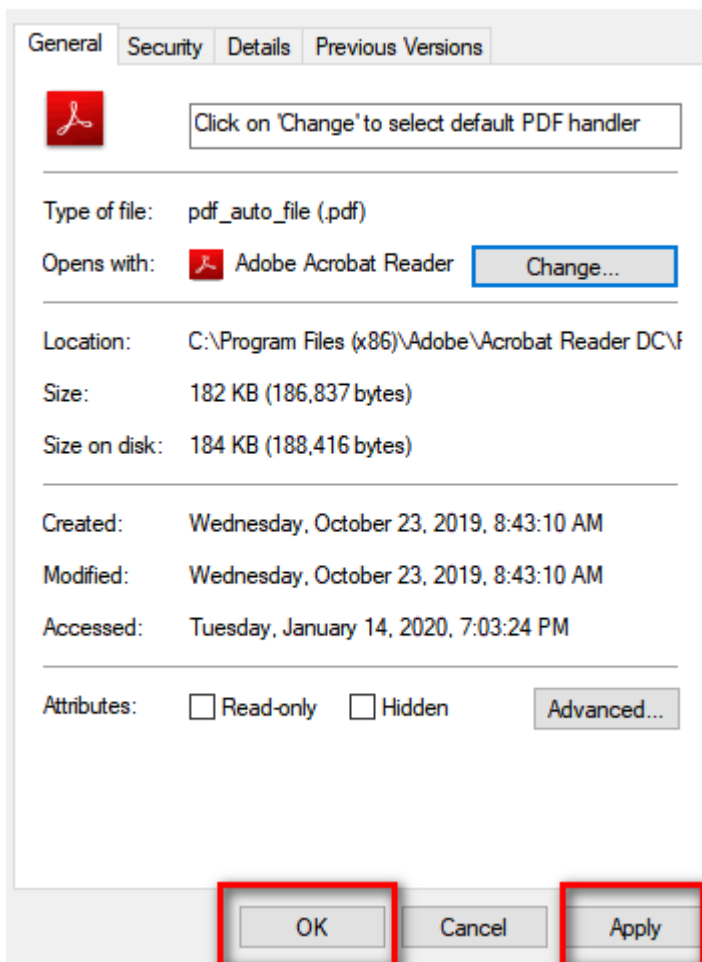


Choose **OK**



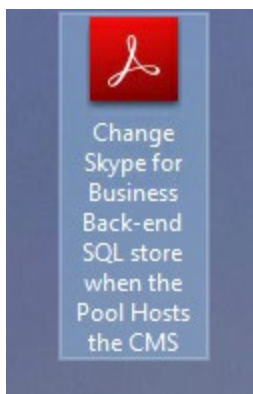
then choose **apply and OK**

Click on 'Change' to select default PDF handler Propert... X

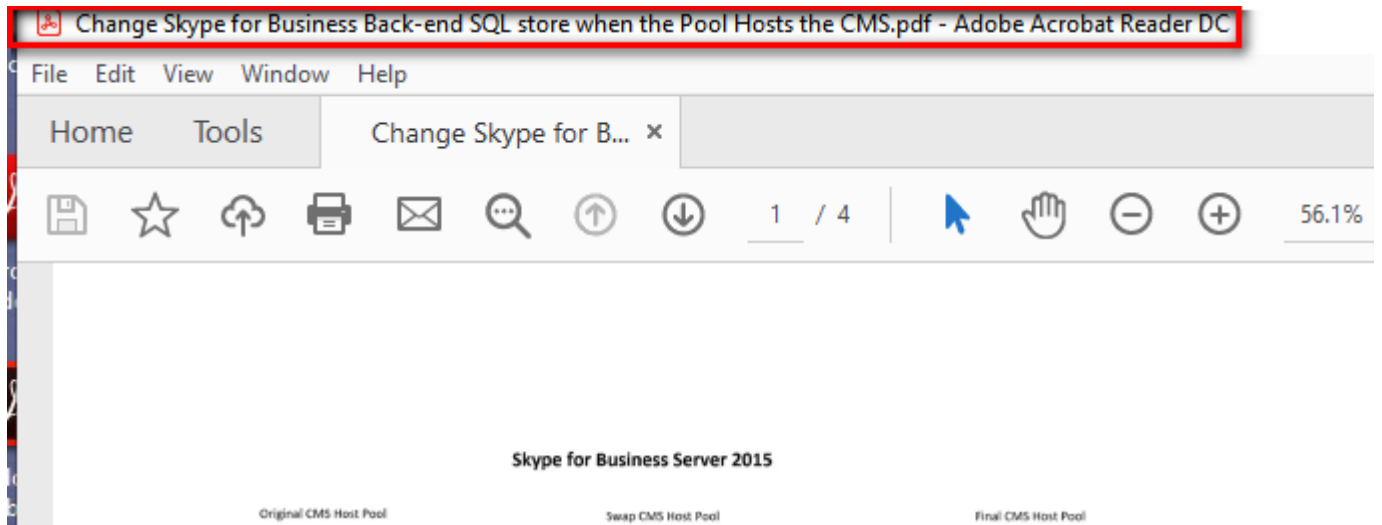


Open PDF files from your desktop or network location
